Rumaki Holiday Programme 2021

General Information

This programme is offered to whanau of Kura Kaupapa and Rumaki Māori. It will operate from 8:30am to 5:30pm daily (excludes public holidays).

We would like you to know:

Kura Kārearea is privately owned and operated business, we will attempt to support whānau if and where we can.

Our ratio of tamariki to caregivers is 10:1 or better, or 6:1 on excursions

We will provide healthy morning and afternoon snacks. This usually consists of cut up fruit and/or vegetables. Sweet treats such as cakes are kept for special occasions such as birthdays and a few other holidays. Tamariki must bring their own Patara-Wai (water bottle).

In warmer weather we will provide sunscreen, however if your tamaiti has sensitive skin please provide a sunblock that can be applied.

Please provide a potae, this gives extra protection from UV rays on outdoor days.

A supply of equipment is available for tamariki (balls, bats, puzzles, books, art materials, lego and other fun activities that our tamariki develop an interest in.

Activities will be age appropriate and group appropriate. However, there will be times where we will be doing activities as a roopu.

As Te Kura o Te Koutu have given us the use of their facilities, we have to take care of what we use and expect our tamariki in our care to do the same.

Children must be collected by 5:30pm or a late penalty may be charged.

Tamariki can only leave the care of Kura Kārearea when collected by their parent or nominated caregiver.

Facebook & Instagram are used by Kura Kārearea, at times we will use images of your tamariki if you have signed permission for us to do so.

Facebook – We have 2 closed mātua groups 1) Afterschool Care & 2) Holiday Programme. Both are another form sharing pānui and whakaahua. We ask that imagery of tamariki are not shared externally unless permission has been granted by the other mātua.
